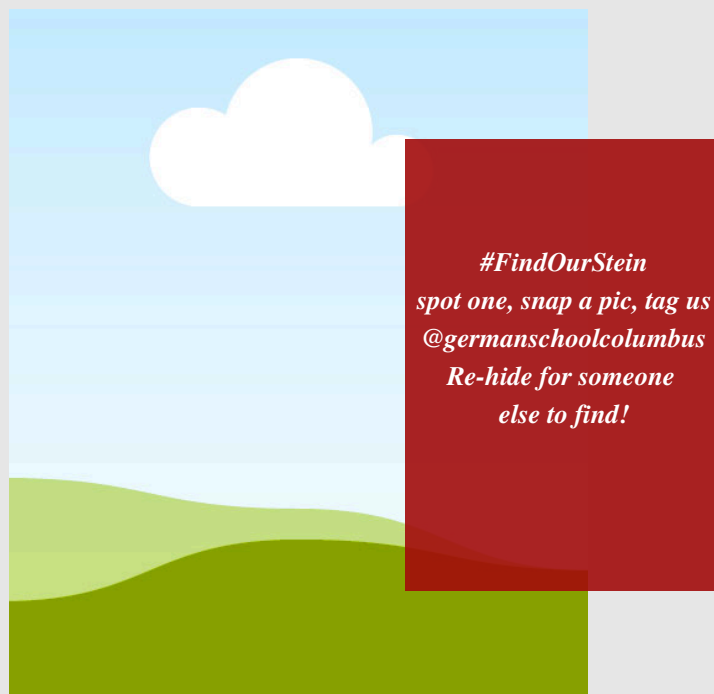


LATERNE, LATERNE, SONNE, MOND & STERNE
